11. She didn't feel well. She went to school anyway. **She didn't feel well but she went to school anyway.**

12. He loves to paint. He's not very good at it. **He loves to pain but he's not very good at it.**

13. I need to finish my project. The deadline is tomorrow. **I need to finish my project because the deadline is tomorrow.**

14. The cake was delicious. Everyone asked for the recipe. **The cake was delicious so everyone asked for the recipe.**

15. They wanted to go on vacation. They didn't have enough money. **They wanted to go on vacation but they didn't have enough money.**

16. She brought her umbrella. It might rain later. **She brought an umbrella because it might rain later.**

17. He likes reading books. He prefers watching movies. **He likes reading books but prefers watching movies.**

18. We were late for the concert. The traffic was heavy. **We were late for the concert because traffic was heavy.**
