CBSE Class X Second Board Examination 2026 - Submission of Consent

Dear Parents,

This is to inform you that, as per the guidelines issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education in alignment with the National Education Policy 2020, an optional **Second Board Examination** will be conducted for students of Class X.

1. Overview

- The Second Examination is an **optional opportunity for improvement of performance**.
- It is tentatively scheduled to be held in **May 2026**.
- Students may appear in a **maximum of three subjects**.
- The facility is available to students who are **declared passed, eligible, or placed in compartment**.

2. Subjects

- Students may opt for up to three subjects from the following:
 - Science
 - Mathematics
 - Social Science
 - Languages

3. Important Information

- **Internal Assessment marks will remain unchanged.**
- Improvement will be considered only for the written examination component.

4. Eligibility Criteria

- The student must have appeared in the **main Board Examination**.
- The student must have appeared in **at least three subjects**.
- Students who have missed three or more subjects or are placed under the **Essential Repeat (ER)** category are **not eligible**.

5. Submission of LOC (List of Candidates)

- Phase 1 submission window: **18 March 2026 to 31 March 2026**.

6. Submission of Consent (Mandatory)

Parents are required to note the following:

- A **written consent/application** must be submitted for opting the Second Examination.
- The application must be submitted **through ERP to the Class Teacher**.
- **Last date for submission: Saturday, 28 March 2026.**
- Applications received after the due date may not be entertained.

7. Examination Fee Details (As per CBSE Annexure)

- ₹320 per subject (₹960 for 3 subjects)
- Late Fee: ₹2000 per candidate (in addition to the normal fee)
- Payment Timeline: **Monday, 30 March 2026. ----- URGENT**

8. Advisory for Parents

- Parents are advised to **carefully assess the need** for improvement in consultation with their ward.
- Subject selection should be done **judiciously (maximum three subjects)**.
- Timely submission of consent and compliance with school instructions is essential.

You are requested to adhere strictly to the above guidelines.
