Terms and Conditions – Educational Movie Outing

Instructions for Students

1. Students shall be permitted to carry only a personal water bottle inside the theatre premises.
2. All participating students are required to maintain proper discipline and strictly comply with the instructions issued by the accompanying teachers and school authorities at all times during the outing.
3. Students must adhere to all safety, behavioural, and venue-specific guidelines communicated by the school and theatre management.

Restrictions

1. Tiffins, snacks, beverages, or any outside food items shall not be permitted inside the theatre.
2. The school shall not be responsible for any prohibited items carried by students contrary to the above instructions.

Refreshments

Complimentary popcorn and a soft drink, as arranged by the organizers, shall be provided to each participating student during the movie screening.

Schedule

- **08:00 a.m.** – Attendance verification, headcount, and boarding of buses.
- **08:15 a.m.** – Departure from the school premises.
- **Post Screening** – Return journey to the school.
- **Dispersal** – Students shall be dispersed as per the regular school dispersal schedule.

Participation and Consent

1. Participation in the movie outing is strictly voluntary and shall be permitted only upon receipt of the duly completed and signed consent form from the parent/guardian within the stipulated timeline.
2. Students whose consent forms are not submitted shall not be allowed to participate in the outing, and the decision of the school in this regard shall be final and binding.
3. By signing and submitting the consent form, parents/guardians acknowledge that they have understood the nature of the activity and authorize their ward's participation under the supervision of school staff.

Refund Policy

1. Parents/guardians who do not wish their ward to participate in the movie outing may submit a written request through email to the school seeking withdrawal from the activity.
2. Upon such withdrawal, the student's enrolment under the Newspaper in Education (NIE) programme associated with the outing shall also stand cancelled.
3. Any eligible refund, after adjustment of charges already incurred or committed by the school towards the programme, shall be processed in accordance with the school's financial policies. The decision of the school regarding the refund amount and admissibility shall be final.

School's Rights

The school reserves the right to deny participation to any student whose conduct, safety concerns, non-compliance with instructions, or lack of requisite consent may affect the orderly and safe conduct of the outing. The school's decision in all such matters shall be final and binding on all concerned.

Disclaimer

While all reasonable care and supervision shall be exercised by the school and accompanying staff, parents/guardians acknowledge that participation in the outing is subject to normal travel and public venue conditions. The school shall not be held liable for any unforeseen circumstances beyond its reasonable control.
